BART Prepares For Strike, May Use Managers To Keep Trains Running

CBS San Francisco Sep 13, 2013

OAKLAND (KCBS / KPIX 5) — With a possible BART strike looming in October, the transit agency and the Metropolitan Transportation Commission are working on contingency plans in the event of a walkout. One of the ideas being considered is limited train service operated by managers...

Union officials said BART is playing with people's lives, and that the managers don't have the proper experience to operate a train.

BART was the first of several subway systems over the last 40 tears to operate with automation. Except in yard limits at slow speeds with operators at the controls BART trains have been mostly run by computers for over 40 years. The primary job of the operators is to check the doors at the station to insure no one gets stuck at the door going in or out of the train while it is moving. There have been several times when operators have left their cabs only to find their BART or Washington Metro trains left the station without them. When this happens the passengers can't get out of the trains at their stops or get on since without the operator the train doors won't open. NB

BART safety record stellar compared to other services

According to the California Public Utilities Commission, from 2009 through May of this year, BART racked up 42 reportable rail transit safety incidents. How did other metropolitan areas and services score? San Diego chalked up 92 incidents, while Sacramento had 192. Santa Clara VTA had 109 reportable incidents compared to Los Angeles County MTA's 180. San Francisco MTA had a whopping 366. Relatively, BART comes off as a safety star.

BART has an advantage being fully grade separated and having an automated service which takes away most issues of human error. NB
